1. Executive Summary:

*Major outcomes, results and impact of the Chair, including on national policies, in relation to its objectives as stated in Article 2 of the Chair Agreement (between the Institution and UNESCO)

1. The Chair has extended its activity not only at the host institution but outside it by introducing its teaching practices and courses to a number leading Russian universities.
2. Two substantial teaching books have been published: a) Stepanyants M.T. Eastern Philosophies. *Text Book for Universities. Moscow : Academ proect* », 2011. 550 pp. ; b) Rykov S.Y. Ancient Chinese Philosophy. Lectures. Moscow : IPH, 2012, 313 pp.
3. Symposium « Rabindranath Tagore, Pablo Neruda and Aimé Césaire for a Reconciled Universal» (18 October 2011) and Third Moscow International Conference on Comparative Philosophy “Philosophy and Science in the Cultures of East and West” (May 22 - 25, 2012) have been organized and hold place at the Institute of Philosophy, Russian Academy of Sciences.
4. The cooperation with two UNESCO Chairs have been carried on: Chair on Comparative Studies of Spiritual Traditions, their Specific Cultures and Interreligious Dialogue (Saint Petersburg) in the framework of the UNESCO/UNITWIN Network on Interreligious Dialogue for Intercultural Understanding and UNESCO Chair in Philosophy, Maltepe University (Turkey), by participating in UNESCO Philosophy Chairs Project “Rethinking Education”.
5. The project « Schools of the Dialogue of Cultures » have been started and retraining of the teachers of 40 secondary schools from 16 regions of Russia hold place. It is a pilopt project which aims to bring intercultural education in the schools system of Russia.

Overview of activities undertaken by the Chair during the reporting period

a) Education/Training/Research

(key education programmes and training delivered and research undertaken by the Chair during the reporting period, target group and geographical coverage)

i) Education (leading to certificate)

- a) Lecture course “The Introduction to Eastern Thought” (60 hours) and seminars (30 hours) were carried on annually for all the undergraduates at the philosophy faculty and the faculty of political studies of the State Academic University for Humanities (more than 70 students all together). Taking into consideration that the presentation of detailed histories of Eastern traditions in terms of names, schools, systems, and so on is practically impossible because of the time limits, the Introduction course was organized topically by introducing to the students the key notions – those concerning the general structure of the universe, the place and mission of the human being within it, and the means and ways to apprehend the Truth, etc. Every topic was presented in a comparative way. At the seminars the students read and discussed the source texts (originals translated from Sanskrit, Chinese and Arabic into Russian).
- b) For those students who wished to go further and get broader knowledge of non-Western philosophies, there were organized language classes in Sanskrit, Persian and Chinese as well as weekly special lecture courses. These students got tuition in preparing course papers and diplomas:

Although today everywhere and at all levels it is common to talk about a dialogue of civilizations and cultures, in reality to carry on such a dialogue are ready neither political elites nor the public as a whole. Skills for caring dialogue do not arise by themselves. They are obtained. And in the process of gaining them the crucial role belongs to educational institutions and their practices. Intercultural education could be one of the most important tools in a transition from abstract and often simply demagogic declarations to practical implementations. The purpose of intercultural education is not only to create a favorable climate for coexistence of different cultures, but also to profit as much as possible from that diversity for the sake of both individual and common perfection. Up till now nowhere intercultural education has been fully practiced as an integral part of education. A major initiative to change the situation has recently come from World Public Forum "The Dialogue of Civilizations", whose leadership intends to transform the network of educational units in JSC «Russian railways» into the schools of the dialogue of cultures. For that purpose the Memorandum on cooperation with UNESCO Chair "Philosophy in the Dialogue of Cultures" have been signed. It is quite evident that to carry out a large-scale project, which could become a "pilot project" in the transformation of the entire educational system of the Russian Federation, is not a matter of a single day. Since September 2011 the first steps for implementing the project have been made: 1. The concept of "The schools of the dialogue of cultures" has been formulated.
 2. Brainstorming session at the UNESCO Headquarters hold place.
 3. Training courses for 40 school teachers (24- 28 September 2012) were presented by the Chair at the Institute of philosophy.
 4 .Round table at he 10th session of the World Public Forum “Dialogue of Civilizations” on Rhodes (6 October, 2012) hold place and resulted in declaring in the Resolution addressed to **Leaders and People of Goodwill Throughout the World:** “Bearing in mind the importance of education for inter-civilizational dialogue, the WPF will create a charter of dialogical learning that combines the principles of mutual understanding with educational practices. Both primary and secondary schools around the world that adopt and implement this charter will receive the status of ‘School of Dialogue’, which is certificated by the WPF. This builds on the experience of schools of dialogue initiated by WPF in Russia and the other CIS countries and seeks to promote it worldwide.”


