Профессор Р. Смит о своем курсе лекций:

«The course is designed for colleagues in the Institute, students and people from outside the Institute who may be interested. I will speak in clear English, and I will explain words, but some knowledge of the language is needed.

The purpose of the course is (1) to provide practice in listening, understanding and formulating questions in philosophical English, and (2) to show how Anglophile intellectuals use words as part of their debates, in the past and in the present.

As a historian of science and intellectual historian, I am interested in the knowledge and beliefs which people have had, and claimed to be rational, and how they relate to our understanding in the present. This interest requires that we know what people mean when they use a number of complex and debated words. I discuss key words, words about which people may have different understandings, and I hope that members of the audience will bring their will bring their knowledge of Russian into dialogue with what I say
