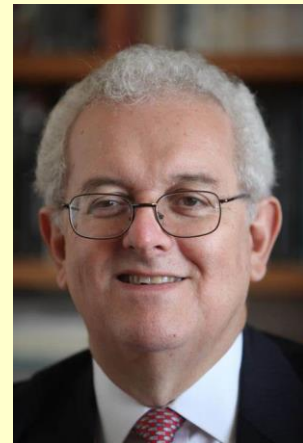
Prof. Alberto Martinelli

Prof. Alberto Martinelli is an outstanding scientist in the field of sociological and political theory in the world. (1) He is the Professor Emeritus of Political Science and Sociology at the University of Milan. (2) He is the President of the International Social Science Council, UNESCO. (3) He was the former President of the International Sociological Association (1998-2002). (4) He received the honorary title of Grand Officer by the President of the Italian in 2012. (5) He is the co-chair of the scientific advisory committee of the IMF, and co-chair of the IMF.



Prof. Jose Antonio Ocampo

Prof. Jose Antonio Ocampo is world-renowned economist. (1) He is the Professor and Co-Director of the Economic and Political Development Concentration in the School of International and Public Affairs, Member of the Committee on Global Thought and co-President of the Initiative for Policy Dialogue at Columbia University. (2) He is also the Chair of the Committee for Development Policy, an expert committee of the United Nations Economic and Social Council. (3) He is the Minister of Finance of the Republic of Colombia. (4) He was former Under-Secretary-General for Economic and Social Affairs of the United Nations; (5) He is the co-chair of the scientific advisory committee of the IMF, and co-chair of the IMF.

International Modernization Forum

International Modernization Forum was initiated by China Center for Modernization Research at Chinese Academy of Sciences (CAS) in 2013, and Center for World Modernization Process of Peking University, Center for Comparative Studies of Modernization of Fudan University, *Science Focus* are the co-sponsors in 2022. The forum is supported by Bureau of Development and Planning of CAS and Bureau of International Cooperation, CAS.

Modernization has been a worldwide phenomenon and a global trend since about 18th century. It not only affects every aspect of human life, but also changes the pattern of world's development. Modernization is just like an international marathon game of national development, in which front runners are developed countries while the rest, developing countries. Almost all countries in the world are undergoing some kind of modernization consciously or unconsciously at present, and the modernization drive can also be set as a national goal directly or indirectly. Studying the nature and explaining the principles of modernization is a shared responsibility of the world's scientific community.

International Modernization Forum aims to serve as an open and non-profit key platform at international level for promoting the modernization study and process; to encourage the advancement of modernization science by promoting the multidisciplinary, interdisciplinary, international comparative and cooperative researches on modernization; to provide the service to its member through bringing together the scholars worldwide, creating a open international network, hosting series conference, exchanging the most up-to-date information related to modernization study; to provide advice and relevant information to institutions and decision makers on the development and implementation of policies and strategies on modernization.

In order to achieve these objectives, the Forum shall have as means of action: to organize the International Modernization Forum once every three years; to create an international network and website on modernization studies and improve the exchange of information in the modernization science; to organize, co-organize, participate in or sponsor the other kinds of conferences and activities on modernization studies; to draft, edit, co-edit publications with respect to modernization studies; to organize or participate in the training activities on modernization studies; to establish the partnership with other organizations whose action strengthen or add value to the Forum's activities; any activity compatible with the objectives of the Forum.
